These are awarded housing benefit payments

All pay payments are made either using a rent card or direct debit

As an example: On this rent account statement, housing benefit was last paid onto the account on the 4th January 2021. This means that two weeks housing benefit is owed and this amount would equal £448.58. You would then need to take this amount (£448.58) off the <u>ACCOUNT BALANCE</u> (£800.42) and this would mean that the outstanding amount owed is £351.84.
